

## Advert: SMMEs in Agricultural sector (fresh produce)

A recent household affordability study has found that residents in the Northern Cape, especially in Springbok are having to dig deeper into their pockets for a basket of basic foodstuffs. The study found that the cost of core foods in the household food basket continued to be a concern. The enterprise development contribution of agribusinesses to especially rural societies and communities in our country is significant. The study found that last year September, in Springbok a household food basket was R3,989,84.

Springbok was R200 more expensive than areas like Durban, Cape Town, Pietermaritzburg. Given this background, the wind farm believes that SMMEs in the agri-sector especially subsistence farmers, have a vital role to play in addressing food insecurity.

For this reason, Kangnas Wind Farm would like to support and nurture Small, Medium and Micro Enterprises (SMMEs) within the Namakhoi agricultural economy.
